Hi Everyone -

Thank you for your ongoing input as we continue to consult with the Hawaii State Historic Preservation Division (SHPD) on the effect determinations for the Pearl Harbor National Historic Landmark and CINCPAC Headquarters Building. Since submitting the Historic Effects Report for review, we have received letters indicating that the SHPD and National Parks Service (NPS) do not concur with the project team's No Adverse Effect determination. We have carefully considered the content of these letters, as well as the input offered in the subsequent meeting with the SHPD and conference call with the NPS. We have responded to your letters with written responses as well, including the requested visual simulations. In some cases, we have not received substantial information as to why this effect determination is in dispute, other than statements indicating that there is no concurrence.

We invite you and your staff to participate in a conference call on June 30th at 10 am HST/1pm PST to discuss your concerns and our recent changes to the project to minimize potential adverse effects. In an effort to address the concerns that have been articulated, our project team has re-designed several aspects of the project, minimizing the physical impacts within the NHL boundary. We have provided this information to you in our written responses and will be pleased to discuss it in more detail.
