Hi Patty--

I hope this email finds you well. In January, you were so kind to escort me around Pearl Harbor as I completed the effects assessment for the Honolulu High Capacity Transit Corridor project (the elevated light-rail system). Those assessments were included in the recent Historic Effects Report document, which we sent to Mr. John Muraoka on April 15, 2009, with a proposed 30-day review period as required under Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act. To date, we have not received any comments from the Navy. Of course, we want to consider any input that your office may have. However, if the Navy has no comment, would it be possible for you to forward either an email or a letter stating that you have no responses to the content as it relates to the Pearl Harbor resources. (Essentially, the report contains no alterations from the effects impacts that we discussed during our site visit.) Normally, if the 30 days have passed, we assume that there is no comment, but we want to be extra careful and actually document that the Navy had no response.
