Hi Ted –

This is to follow-up on our telephone conversation yesterday.

As I related to you yesterday, I was not aware that Jim Barr wanted to see the comments and responses prior to the Administrative FEIS. My understanding was that FTA wanted to see the complete document and not chapter by chapter submittals. The only exceptions would be Chapter 5, Section 4(f) and possibly the part of Chapter 4 regarding Historic Resources; the reason being that these sections would be changed from the DEIS. We are currently planning to submit the Administrative FEIS with the comments/responses on June 18th for your review. By the end of this week we plan to get you a summary of the comments received and our responses to those comments. We were also planning to include a few representative comment and response letters.

I also wanted to confirm our meeting with you in San Francisco on July 6th. Hope this is still ok.

Today we met with the SHPD to go over their comments. We will be scheduling a field trip with their reviewer to see if we can get them to concur with our effect determination. Our conference call with the National Park Service is “on” for Friday, June 5th. I sent you the call-in numbers in a separate message. The SHPD is arranging for us to meet with the ACHP staff who will be teaching a class in Honolulu over the next two days. The meeting will be held on Friday.

After all of this is done, we would like to brief you on the outcome of these meetings. Can we schedule a conference call for Tuesday, June 9th?

During the conference call, we would also like to discuss our Section 4(f) documentation. We have over 15 Section 4(f) resources that are affected.

That is all for now.
