There IS a State project in the 2030 ORTP to widen Farrington Highway "1 lane in each direction from west of Ft Weaver Road to Waiawa Interchange". This project is in the 2016 - 2030 time bin. This project is not on our near term (10 year) radar yet... So, not surprisingly, it's not on the STIP/TIP.
