The call agenda is the SHPD letters, I have a few notes to offer with questions about the FTA responses that may start the discussion:

- Ewa Field is more than a mile from the end of our project. It is in an extension area. We have some data on resources in that vicinity, I propose providing everything we have to SHPD, but not extending the APE more than a mile from the project. There is an ulterior motive to this request related to the Navy.
- We are working further thoughts on indirect/constructive use, would like to discuss approach and our understanding of regulations and agency guidance.
- Generally agree on proposed additional mitigation, working it into EIS section to send today.
- Need to discuss Chinatown, this is related to determining an Adverse Effect to a district when there is no direct effect to any contributing resource.
- On ACHP, no pro forma letter yet; however, from a discussion with SHPD we were preparing such a letter. Would like FTA's advice.
- Some of HHF proposed mitigation is not within the jurisdiction of DTS.
