Outline of information needed in the PE application, FTA's review time including the Congressional review, and the fact that the FTA engineering will have additional 30 to 45 days for their review of cost estimates before accepting the application. Ron,

The Mayor asked me about receiving a letter from you regarding your advice of potentially delaying the PE application. I believe you mentioned to the Mayor at the DC meeting that you will write to us about the need for the preliminary review of the application document prior to the formal submittal. I understood that you were cautious about our schedule of submitting the application in March and advised the Mayor that Honolulu should take time in coordinating with FTA prior to the formal submittal. Such coordination would help Honolulu in preparing the application in the way to expedite the FTA review. I advised the Mayor that I informed you Honolulu is already in coordination with the FTA PMO and the PMO agrees that the formal submission could occur in next few months. Today you brought up a different concern that could delay the schedule (due to the current event relating to the technology selection). We will deal with that issue separately but the Mayor still would like to receive your letter based on your advice in DC.
