**It was good seeing you at APTA, and indeed fortunate that we connected over an impromptu lunch.**

**Attached is a preliminary flyer about the Symposium in Honolulu on November 13. The layout and format will change slightly, but the content will not.**

**Each of the cities highlighted (San Francisco, Salt Lake City, Vancouver and Los Angeles) will be asked to come to the seminar with at least two, but not more than four representatives. Ideally, the CEO/GM will address the attendees in the first morning panel; a business leader/citizen activist (or both) will address the attendees in the second morning panel; and the person most familiar with the community's transit-oriented development activities (developer, chamber of commerce leader, transit authority planner, etc) will lead an informal discussion of the TOD and joint development activities in each community during the afternoon "open house" sessions. The City/County of Honolulu will cover airfare and hotel costs, and will make the arrangements for you and your colleagues.**

**I'll be sending a more formal confirmation letter in the next day or two.**
