



# We invite you to join Mayor Mufi Hannemann at the City and County of Honolulu's Second Annual Transit Symposium

The 2007 Transit Symposium will feature representatives from among these major cities with transit systems in various stages of development – Vancouver, Canada, Salt Lake City, Utah, Washington D.C., Denver, Colorado and Los Angeles, California. Representatives from these cities will discuss key aspects of their project development in two panel discussion sessions and in open house breakout sessions. The panel discussions will focus on managing growing transit systems and energizing business and community involvement throughout the development of a fixed guideway transit system.

Dr. Martin Wachs, the Director of Transportation and Infrastructure Programs at the RAND Corporation in Santa Monica, California will moderate the panel discussion sessions.

For the afternoon session, representatives and panelists from the featured cities will be in separate breakout rooms sharing information about their respective transit systems. Symposium participants can engage directly with the city representatives and deepen their first-hand knowledge of these systems.

## Topic 1: Managing a Growing Transit System

While a major investment in transit can be a boom for a city, it is critical that the governing body be prepared to manage the investment and its systems. This panel will discuss how have other governmental agencies successfully integrated and managed major additions to their transit systems. Topics of discussion will include: transit agency policies and configuration; risk management; and transition through the system life-cycle (design, construction, operation and maintenance).

## Topic 2: Business and Community Involvement

Businesses and the community are vital to the success of a major urban transit system. This panel will discuss actions that can be undertaken by businesses and citizens to assure appropriate influence and support in the development of a major urban transit system.

## Open House Discussion Sessions - FREE

Information about each of the featured cities transit systems and the panelists will host individual open house discussions in the afternoon. Symposium participants will be able to engage directly with the respective city representatives and deepen their first-hand knowledge of these systems.
