Mark and Toru,

There seem to be a lot of reports that you have, and I want to clarify what FTA needs to review. We want to review the Detailed Definition of Alternatives report – that's the documentation describing the capital elements and operating plans for the rail and bus services of each alternative. That is usually given to us before equilibration is done, but if you are close to an equilibrated service plan you can give us that. I can look at the FTP site with the documentation there to see if the information presented is complete, realizing that the service plans in that are changing, and that we will have to review how they have changed eventually.

It appears that no forecasts have been given to Jim but they will be finished in late October/early November. We will review those when you send them in.

Let me verify with Heather which alternatives she sent. We have forecasts for the "MOS" as adopted by City Council (i.e. the 20 mile project via Salt Lake Boulevard) and I'll verify that was included in the package she sent. The updated version of the documentation of the definition of alternatives is what you'll need to go with that. As noted, we should be able to get that to you shortly.

My understanding from Bill Davidson's discussions with Jim Ryan is that Jim is also waiting to review new forecasts for the project that we'll be preparing once we've finished a set of model updates that Jim has requested. Our current schedule is to have the model updates completed in late October, at which time we'll provide Jim with documentation on the updates. We'll then proceed with making new forecasts which should be finished in November.
