**Hamada moved, seconded by Remington that the Mililani/Waipio/Melemanu Neighborhood Board No. 25 strongly urges the City and County of Honolulu Department of Transportation Services to make the high capacity transit corridor available to Central O'ahu commuters by developing appropriate transportation improvements such as express bus service in dedicated lanes between Central O'ahu and the nearest high capacity transit corridor station with adequate and reasonably priced long term parking to foster a smooth, efficient and "seamless" transition between the various modes of transit for Central O'ahu commuters. The resolution was unanimously adopted, 20-0-0.**
