This is a follow up meeting we had with City & County DTS on 25 Jan 06. (yes, this is very late and I apologize)

They asked for the Navy's input on an Alternative 4b - see attached, you have to zoom in on image. The route runs along Kamehameha and Nimitz Highways and then cuts through housing via Camp Catlin Road.

Since this proposed route is elevated above grade CAPT Roth did not foresee problem with proposed route along Kamehameha Highway and Nimitz. However he wanted to get your input on proposal along Camp Catlin Road and impact to Housing development.
