Yukie,

Here are some of the answers to the list of questions we had yesterday.

1) Yes, you can call in to Jan 17 mtg, and you also need to web-conference on PS2 (per my other email). You'll be calling our multi-party call line, "Raindance". (Remember that?) The number below is correct, and the Conference ID # will most likely be this one, but to be confirmed later.

2) There is no compelling reason for you to attend the meeting in person. There will be no site visits.

3) You and Maya can both participate. Apparently, the instruction should have been a "maximum of 2" people from each group should participate in the meeting. It makes sense for Maya to be there. (Please let me know if she will not be coming here in person; if she wants to dial-in, I need to set her up on our PS2 system as well.)

4) The meeting itself will be 2-3 hours. Considering potential debrief, plus initial prep on your part (e.g. PS2 log-in), Maya's travel time, I think you might want to budget 7-8 hrs for this first work order, which is limited to this kick-off meeting. So I just need a lump sum estimate for that. Pls send me that number anytime before the meeting.

5) As I said, your master agreement cap will be \$30,000. Those are the funds available to cover your work thru completion of the Alternatives Analysis phase.

6) FYI - We may need to tap you for a little more than just wetlands and wildlife. We have another sub to help with street trees/landscaping, but I would like your help on any other biological issue that comes up that doesn't fit into one of those categories. To be determined, as the work ramps up.

That's it for now. Call me if you have other questions. I'll be getting back to you on the master agreement contract a little later. Otherwise, talk to you Tuesday. Really great that we get to work together again!!
