As discussed, we are shooting to get the PA execution completed by the end of the week. The original intent was to get all of the signatures on one page, with the Honolulu signatures completed first, followed by FTA Region IX in San Francisco and then ending with the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation in Washington DC.

The Admiral being in DC this week puts a wrinkle in our original plans. Is Admiral Smith the only one who can sign the PA? Can he delegate someone else to sign for him?
