

## **HONOLULU AUTHORITY FOR RAPID TRANSPORTATION (HART) BOARD MEMBERS HOLD FIRST MEETING TOMORROW**

(Thurs., June 30, 2011) — The newly created Honolulu Authority for Rapid Transportation (HART) Board of Directors will be sworn in and conduct its first meeting tomorrow at 8 a.m. in the City's Mission Memorial Annex Conference Room located at 550 South King Street.

The new public transit authority was created through an amendment to the City Charter, which was approved by 63 percent of Oahu voters last November. The board is the policymaking arm of the authority, which is charged with overseeing the design, construction, operation and maintenance of Honolulu's first urban rail transit system.
