
TRAFFIC ADVISORY: LANE CLOSURES PLANNED ALONG KAMEHAMEHA HIGHWAY IN PEARL CITY

The Honolulu Authority for Rapid Transportation (HART) wants to inform drivers of lane closures along Kamehameha Highway between Acacia Road and Waimano Home Road in Pearl City beginning next week as part of rail construction.

The 24-hour lane closures, scheduled to begin Monday evening, March 16, and run through late 2015, are needed to allow crews to safely conduct column shaft and foundation work along the highway median for the planned rail guideway:

- **One eastbound left-turn lane from Kamehameha Highway onto Waimano Home Road and the inside eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway between Acacia Road and Waimano Home Road will be closed 24 hours a day.**
- **One westbound left-turn lane from Kamehameha Highway onto Lehua Avenue and the inside westbound lane of Kamehameha Highway between Waimano Home Road and Acacia Road will also be closed 24 hours a day as part of the column foundation work. Westbound U-turns will still be allowed at the Waimano Home Road intersection.**

Motorists who routinely use this stretch of Kamehameha Highway should provide themselves extra time during their commute. Drivers should also be aware of similar lane closures currently taking place along Kamehameha Highway at the adjacent Acacia Road intersection.
