

City Center Traffic Update | Week of February 16, 2014

The Honolulu Authority for Rapid Transportation (HART) wants drivers to be aware of weekly lane closures in the urban Honolulu area as related to the Honolulu rail transit project.

For the safety of both the work crews and motorists, the public is advised to proceed with caution through these areas. Drivers should anticipate possible traffic delays or use alternate routes during work hours, and provide a safe distance between their vehicles and workers and equipment.

Lane closures will take place at the following locations in Kalihi and Iwilei next week for soil testing and trenching work:

- Left lanes of Dillingham Boulevard in both the eastbound and westbound directions between Laumaka Street and Kalihi Street from Tuesday, February 18 to Friday, February 21 between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.
- Northbound lane of Iwilei Road between Sumner Street and North King Street on Thursday, February 20 and Friday, February 21 between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m.

Overnight lane closures will take place at the following location in downtown Honolulu from Sunday, February 16 to Thursday, February 20 between 8:30 p.m. and 4 a.m. for soil testing:

- Left lanes of Nimitz Highway in both eastbound and westbound directions between River Street and Punchbowl Street

Lane closures will take place at the following location in downtown Honolulu on Tuesday, February 18 and Wednesday, February 19 between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. for trenching work:

- Ewa-bound left lane of Nimitz Highway between River Street and Sumner Street.
