


City Center Traffic Update | Week of February 23, 2014

The Honolulu Authority for Rapid Transportation (HART) wants drivers to be aware of weekly lane closures in the urban Honolulu area as related to the Honolulu rail transit project.

For the safety of both the work crews and motorists, the public is advised to proceed with caution through these areas. Drivers should anticipate possible traffic delays or use alternate routes during work hours, and provide a safe distance between their vehicles and workers and equipment.

Lane closures will take place in Kalihi from Monday, February 24 to Friday, February 28 between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. for soil testing and trench work:

- Left lanes of Dillingham Boulevard in both the eastbound and westbound directions between Laumaka Street and McNeill Street
- Northbound lane of Iwilei Road between Sumner Street and North King Street on Monday, February 24 and Tuesday, February 25 between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m.

Overnight lane closures will take place in downtown Honolulu from Sunday, February 23 to Thursday, February 27 between 8:30 p.m. and 4 a.m. for soil testing:

- Left lanes of Nimitz Highway in both eastbound and westbound directions between River Street and Punchbowl Street

Daytime lane closures will take place in Kaka'ako next week for soil testing and trench work:

- Two eastbound lanes of Halekauwila Street will be closed between Cooke Street and Kamani Street from Monday, February 24 to Friday, February 28 between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. Eastbound drivers will be contraflowed to the other travel lanes.
- Halekauwila Street between Cooke Street and Ahui Street will be closed from Monday, February 24 to Friday, February 28 between 7:30 a.m. and 4 p.m. Drivers are asked to use other adjacent streets during the closure.

- Media Advisory Traffic Update distributed to local media on 2/21 and on 2/28.

DOWNTOWN/KAKA`AKO

Overnight lane closures will take place in downtown Honolulu from Sunday, February 23 to Thursday, February 27 between 8:30 p.m. and 4 a.m. for soil testing:

- Left lanes of Nimitz Highway in both eastbound and westbound directions between River Street and Punchbowl Street

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DOWNTOWN/KAKA`AKO

Lane closures will take place this weekend in downtown Honolulu on Saturday, March 1 and Sunday, March 2 between 7 a.m. and 8:30 p.m. for trench work:

- Three southbound lanes of Punchbowl Street between Pohukaina Street and Ala Moana Boulevard.

Overnight lane closures will take place in downtown Honolulu from Sunday, March 2 to Thursday, March 6 between 8:30 p.m. and 4 a.m. the following morning for soil testing:

- Left lanes of Nimitz Highway in both eastbound and westbound directions between River Street and Punchbowl Street

Daytime lane closures will take place in Kaka`ako next week for soil testing and trench work:

- **Halekauwila Street between Cooke Street and Ahui Street will be closed** from Monday, March 3 to Wednesday, March 5 between 7:30 a.m. and 4 p.m. Drivers are asked to use other adjacent streets during the closure.
- When the Halekauwila Street closure is not in effect, two eastbound lanes of Halekauwila Street will be closed between Cooke Street and Kamani Street on weekdays between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. Drivers will be directed to the other travel lanes.
