

City Center Traffic Update | Week of April 6, 2014

The Honolulu Authority for Rapid Transportation (HART) wants drivers to be aware of weekly lane closures in the urban Honolulu area as related to the Honolulu rail transit project.

For the safety of both the work crews and motorists, the public is advised to proceed with caution through these areas. Drivers should anticipate possible traffic delays or use alternate routes during work hours, and provide a safe distance between their vehicles and workers and equipment:

Overnight lane closures will take place at the following locations in Kalihi between Sunday, April 6 and Thursday, April 10 between 8 p.m. and 5 a.m. for soil testing:

- Left lanes of Dillingham Boulevard in both eastbound and westbound directions from Laumaka Street to Kaaahi Street.
- Left lanes of Dillingham Boulevard in both the eastbound and westbound directions between Kalihi Street and Kokea Street (near Iwilei Costco).

Road closures will take place in downtown Honolulu on Saturday, April 5 and Sunday, April 6 between 7 a.m. and 8:30 p.m. for trench work:

- Punchbowl Street will be closed between Pohukaina Street and Ala Moana Boulevard. Drivers heading south on Punchbowl Street are asked to use either Halekauwila or Pohukaina streets as detours.
- Halekauwila Street will be closed between Punchbowl Street and South Street. Drivers heading east on Halekauwila Street are asked to use Pohukaina Street as a detour.
- Left eastbound shoulder of Halekauwila Street between Richards Street and Punchbowl Street will be closed.

Overnight lane closures will take place in downtown Honolulu from Sunday, April 6 to Thursday, April 10 between 8:30 p.m. and 4 a.m. for soil testing:

- Left lanes of Nimitz Highway in both eastbound and westbound directions between Maunakea Street and Punchbowl Street

Overnight lanes closures will take place in Kakaako from Sunday, April 6 to Thursday, April 10 between 7:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. for soil testing:

- Right lane of Halekauwila Street in both eastbound and westbound directions between Richards Street and Cooke Street
- Right lane of Kona Street in the eastbound direction between Pensacola Street and Piikoi Street
- Right lane of Piikoi Street in the northbound direction near Kona Street

DOWNTOWN/KAKA'AKO

Road closures will take place this weekend in downtown Honolulu on Saturday, April 5 and Sunday, April 6 between 7 a.m. and 8:30 p.m. for trench work:

- Punchbowl Street will be closed between Pohukaina Street and Ala Moana Boulevard. Drivers heading south on Punchbowl Street are asked to use either Halekauwila or Pohukaina streets as detours.
- Halekauwila Street will be closed between Punchbowl Street and South Street. Drivers heading east on Halekauwila Street are asked to use Pohukaina Street as a detour.
- Left eastbound shoulder of Halekauwila Street between Richards Street and Punchbowl Street will be closed.

Overnight lane closures will take place in downtown Honolulu from Sunday, April 6 to Thursday, April 10 between 8:30 p.m. and 4 a.m. for soil testing:

- Left lanes of Nimitz Highway in both eastbound and westbound directions between Maunakea Street and Punchbowl Street

Overnight lanes closures will take place in Kakaako from Sunday, April 6 to Thursday, April 10 between 7:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. for soil testing:

- Right lane of Halekauwila Street in both eastbound and westbound directions between Richards Street and Cooke Street
- Right lane of Kona Street in the eastbound direction between Pensacola Street and Piikoi Street
- Right lane of Piikoi Street in the northbound direction near Kona Street
