### City Center Traffic Update | Week of April 20, 2014

The Honolulu Authority for Rapid Transportation (HART) wants drivers to be aware of weekly lane closures in the urban Honolulu area as related to the Honolulu rail transit project.

For the safety of both the work crews and motorists, the public is advised to proceed with caution through these areas. Drivers should anticipate possible traffic delays or use alternate routes during work hours, and provide a safe distance between their vehicles and workers and equipment.

Daytime lane closures will take place in Kakaako along Ward Avenue on Friday, April 25 between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. for soil testing:

- Right southbound lane of Ward Avenue between Ilianiwai Street and Halekauwila Street

Overnight lane closures will take place at the following locations in Kalihi between Sunday, April 20 to Thursday, April 24 between 8 p.m. and 5 a.m. for soil testing:

- Left lanes of Dillingham Boulevard in both eastbound and westbound directions from Laumaka Street to Mokauea Street

Overnight lane closures will take place in downtown Honolulu from Sunday, April 20 to Thursday, April 24 between 8:30 p.m. and 4 a.m. for soil testing:

- Left lanes of Nimitz Highway in both eastbound and westbound directions between River Street and Punchbowl Street

Overnight lane closures will take place in Kakaako along Halekauwila Street from Monday, April 21 to Friday, April 25 between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. for soil testing:

- Right eastbound lane of Halekauwila Street between Keawe Street and Ward Avenue

Overnight lane closures will take place in downtown Honolulu from Sunday, April 20 to Thursday, April 24 between 8:30 p.m. and 4 a.m. for soil testing:

- Center lanes of Kona Street in both eastbound and westbound directions between Kamakee Street and Pensacola Street

## **DOWNTOWN/KAKA`AKO**

Lane closures will take place this weekend in Kakaako on Saturday, April 26 between 7 a.m. and 8:30 p.m. for soil testing:

- Left eastbound shoulder of Halekauwila Street between Richards Street and Punchbowl Street
- Halekauwila Street will be closed in both directions between Punchbowl Street and South Street. Drivers are asked to use Pohukaina Street as a detour during those hours.

Daytime weekday lane closures will take place in Kakaako from Monday, April 28 to Friday, May 2 between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. for soil testing:

- Right eastbound lane of Halekauwila Street between Keawe Street and Ward Avenue
