City Center Traffic Update | Week of April 27, 2014

The Honolulu Authority for Rapid Transportation (HART) wants drivers to be aware of weekly lane closures in the urban Honolulu area as related to the Honolulu rail transit project.

For the safety of both the work crews and motorists, the public is advised to proceed with caution through these areas. Drivers should anticipate possible traffic delays or use alternate routes during work hours, and provide a safe distance between their vehicles and workers and equipment:

Lane closures will take place this weekend in Kakaako on Saturday, April 26 between 7 a.m. and 8:30 p.m. for soil testing:

- Left eastbound shoulder of Halekauwila Street between Richards Street and Punchbowl Street
- Halekauwila Street will be closed in both directions between Punchbowl Street and South Street. Drivers are asked to use Pohukaina Street as a detour during those hours.

Daytime weekday lane closures will take place in Kakaako from Monday, April 28 to Friday, May 2 between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. for soil testing:

- Right eastbound lane of Halekauwila Street between Keawe Street and Ward Avenue
- Right southbound lane of Ward Avenue between Queen Street and Halekauwila Street on Monday, April 28 only

Overnight lane closures will take place in downtown Honolulu from Sunday, April 27 to Thursday, May 1 between 9 p.m. to 4 a.m. for soil testing:

- Left lanes of Nimitz Highway in both eastbound and westbound directions between River Street and Punchbowl Street.

Overnight lane closures will take place in Kakaako from Sunday, April 27 to Thursday, May 1 between 8:30 p.m. and 4 a.m. for soil testing:

- Right lanes of Halekauwila Street in both eastbound and westbound directions between Richards Street and South Street
 - Right eastbound lanes of Queen Street from Ward Avenue to the intersection of Queen Street and Waimanu Street.
