

City Center Traffic Update | Week of May 11, 2014

The Honolulu Authority for Rapid Transportation (HART) wants drivers to be aware of weekly lane closures in the urban Honolulu area as related to the Honolulu rail transit project.

For the safety of both the work crews and motorists, the public is advised to proceed with caution through these areas. Drivers should anticipate possible traffic delays or use alternate routes during work hours, and provide a safe distance between their vehicles and workers and equipment.

Lane closures will take place this weekend in Kakaako on Saturday, May 10 and Sunday, May 11 between 7 a.m. and 8:30 p.m. for soil testing:

- Left eastbound shoulder of Halekauwila Street between Richards Street and Punchbowl Street
- Halekauwila Street will be closed in both directions between Punchbowl Street and South Street. Drivers are asked to use Pohukaina Street as a detour during those hours.

Overnight lane closures will take place in downtown Honolulu from Sunday, May 11 to Thursday, May 15 between 8:30 p.m. and 4 a.m. for soil testing:

- Left lanes of Nimitz Highway in both eastbound and westbound directions between Sumner Street and Punchbowl Street.

Daytime weekday lane closures will take place in Kakaako from Monday, May 12 to Friday, May 16 between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. for soil testing:

- Left lanes of Queen Street in both the eastbound and westbound directions between Cummins Street and Pensacola Street

Overnight lane closures will take place in Kakaako from Sunday, May 11 to Thursday, May 15 between 8:30 p.m. and 4 a.m. for soil testing:

- Right westbound lane of Halekauwila Street between Richards Street and Punchbowl Street
- Right eastbound lane of Halekauwila Street between Punchbowl Street and South Street

Intermittent lane closures will take place in downtown Honolulu at the following locations from Wednesday, May 14 to Friday, May 16 between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. and between 8:30 p.m. and 4:30 a.m. the following morning:

- Right eastbound lane of Nimitz Highway between Sumner Street and Nuuanu Avenue
- Right westbound lane of Nimitz Highway from River Street to near Iwilei Road.

DOWNTOWN/KAKA`AKO

Lane closures will take place this weekend in Kakaako on Saturday, May 10 and Sunday, May 11 between 7 a.m. and 8:30 p.m. for soil testing:

- Left eastbound shoulder of Halekauwila Street between Richards Street and Punchbowl Street
- Halekauwila Street will be closed in both directions between Punchbowl Street and South Street. Drivers are asked to use Pohukaina Street as a detour during those hours.

Overnight lane closures will take place in downtown Honolulu from Sunday, May 11 to Thursday, May 15 between 8:30 p.m. and 4 a.m. for soil testing:

- Left lanes of Nimitz Highway in both eastbound and westbound directions between Sumner Street and Punchbowl Street.

Daytime weekday lane closures will take place in Kakaako from Monday, May 12 to Friday, May 16 between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. for soil testing:

- Left lanes of Queen Street in both the eastbound and westbound directions between Cummins Street and Pensacola Street

Overnight lane closures will take place in Kakaako from Sunday, May 11 to Thursday, May 15 between 8:30 p.m. and 4 a.m. for soil testing:

- Right westbound lane of Halekauwila Street between Richards Street and Punchbowl Street
- Right eastbound lane of Halekauwila Street between Punchbowl Street and South Street

Intermittent lane closures will take place in downtown Honolulu at the following locations from Wednesday, May 14 to Friday, May 16 between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. and between 8:30 p.m. and 4:30 a.m. the following morning:

- Right eastbound lane of Nimitz Highway between Sumner Street and Nuuanu Avenue
- Right westbound lane of Nimitz Highway from River Street to near Iwilei Road

DOWNTOWN/KAKA`AKO

Lane closures will take place this weekend in Kakaako on Saturday, May 17 and Sunday, May 18 between 7 a.m. and 8:30 p.m. for soil testing:

- Halekauwila Street will be closed in both directions between Richards Street and South Street. Drivers heading south on Punchbowl Street are asked to use Pohukaina Street as a detour during those hours.

Overnight lane closures will take place in downtown Honolulu from Sunday, May 18 to Thursday, May 22 between 8:30 p.m. and 4 a.m. for soil testing:

- Left lanes of Nimitz Highway in both eastbound and westbound directions between Sumner Street and Punchbowl Street
- One westbound lane and the eastbound shoulder of Halekauwila Street between Richards Street and Punchbowl Street

Daytime weekday lane closures will take place in Kakaako from Monday, May 19 to Friday, May 23 between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. for soil testing:

- Left lanes of Queen Street in both the eastbound and westbound directions between Cummins Street and Pensacola Street

Overnight lane closures will take place in Kakaako from Sunday, May 18 to Thursday, May 22 between 8:30 p.m. and 4 a.m. for soil testing:

- Right eastbound lane of Halekauwila Street between Punchbowl Street and South Street
- Right eastbound lane of Kona Street from Kona Iki Street to Keeaumoku Street
