



West O'ahu/Farrington Highway Guideway Contract

Kiewit Field Work Roadwork and Traffic Update Week of October 9, 2011

Traffic Impacts:

- Crews will work along Farrington Highway between Acacia Road in Pearl City and Kualakai Parkway (North-South Road) in Kapolei. Work requiring lane and shoulder closures will consist of:
 - Trimming and relocating trees within the median of Farrington Highway between Leoku Street and Leokane Street.
 - Locating utilities within the median of Farrington Highway between Mokuola Street and Paiwa Street.
 - Performing landscape maintenance within the median of Farrington Highway between Waipahu Depot Road and Waipahu High School.
 - Drilling for soil samples in Pearl City between Acacia Road and Waiawa Stream.

Evening Traffic Impacts

- Crews will work along the median of Farrington Highway between Mokuola Street and Paiwa Street relocating utilities and drilling for soil samples.

Farrington Highway, H-1 and City Streets Traffic Plan:

- Work will require lane closures with shoulder and median work signage/cones along the side of the road to mark the work area during the following hours:
 - Daytime: Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.
 - Evenings: Sunday through Thursday from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- One lane of traffic in each direction of Farrington Highway will remain open in the designated work areas.
