A GREEN TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVE

HART Executive Director and CEO Dan Grabauskas gave a presentation on Friday, May 10th at the Hawaii Build and Buy Green Conference and Expo at the Hawaii Convention Center.

Grabauskas highlighted the environmental benefits of the Honolulu rail transit project.




He noted that there will be a three percent reduction in total transportation energy consumption on Oahu when rail transit is added to the island's public transportation system.

While three percent may not sound like a lot, it equals the annual energy needed to provide electricity to 6,500 homes and nearly six million gallons of gasoline.

Rail will also lead to a reduction in green house gas emissions of 52,700 metric tons of carbon dioxide every year.

Energy conservation and pollution emission reductions are just two of the many upcoming benefits of rail transit.




BOARD REACHES 100TH MEETING MILESTONE
