ART SUBMITTAL DEADLINE EXTENDED



Nearly 200 people attended the HART Art-In-Transit Program Pre-Submittal Workshop held this past Saturday at Ali'i Place

Due to strong interest and by popular demand, HART has extended by one week the deadline for artists and artist teams to submit their qualifications for the transit art program.

"We want to be responsive and encourage as many submissions as possible," said HART Executive Director and CEO Dan Grabauskas said. "This program is a unique opportunity for artists to be part of creating artwork for our stations and our train control center that will reflect the history and character of the surrounding communities."

The new deadline for submittals is Thursday, June 27, 2013, 7:59 p.m. Hawaii Standard Time.

FULL-SIZE MODEL OF HART'S NEW RAIL VEHICLE FEATURED AT INTERNATIONAL EXHIBITION



A full-size wooden model of Honolulu's driverless rail vehicle was unveiled last week at the 60th UITP World Congress and Mobility & Transport Exhibition in Geneva, Switzerland.

"It was exciting to see Honolulu's rail project showcased at such a prestigious exhibition, which draws transportation officials from all over the world," said HART Executive Director and CEO Dan Grabauskas. "The feedback was nothing but positive."

Ansaldo Honolulu JV provided the model of the train vehicles that the company will manufacture for Honolulu's light metro rail system. The company is scheduled to deliver the first 16 vehicles over the next two years.


