## *RAIL COLUMN WORK BEGINS NEAR H-1/H-2 MERGE*

Heading into town near the H-1/H-2 Freeway merge, crews are busy preparing for the installation of columns that will support the rail guideway as it crosses over the H-1 between Waipahu and Pearl City.

Next week, crews are scheduled to pour concrete for the first column located in the freeway median near the H-1 Waiawa Interchange. Several support columns need to be erected before guideway construction can begin later this fall. The column work will involve the closure of one southbound H-2 lane near the H-1/H-2 merge from Sunday, July 6 to Thursday, July 10 between 8 p.m. and 4 a.m. the following morning.

The support columns for the rail guideway overpass will be placed at intervals along the median areas of the H-1 Freeway, and Kamehameha and Farrington highways where the guideway will cross. When completed, this section of the rail guideway will connect the Leeward Community College station in Waipahu with the Pearl Highlands station in Pearl City.

Safety is HART's top priority, and during the freeway work motorists are asked to proceed

through the construction area with caution. Drivers should allow a safe distance between their vehicles and workers and equipment.

## *WEEKLY TRAFFIC ALERT*



### EWA

Farrington Highway between Kualakai Parkway (North-South Road) and Old Fort Weaver Road will be closed overnight from Monday, July 7 to Friday, July 11 between 7 p.m. and 5 a.m. Motorists should instead use either the H-1 Freeway or Kapolei Parkway.

Left turns from Farrington Highway onto Fort Weaver Road northbound will be restricted 24/7 through July. Eastbound drivers using Farrington Highway will need to take a detour up Leoku Street and use either Leolua Street or Waipahu Street to access Fort Weaver Road.

### H-1 WAIAWA INTERCHANGE

One southbound lane of the H-2 Freeway near the H-1/H-2 merge will be closed Sunday, July 6 to Thursday, July 10 between 8 p.m. and 4 a.m.

### WAIPAHU

Westbound lanes of Farrington Highway near Leokane Street will be closed from Monday, July 7 to Friday, July 11 between 7 p.m. and 6 a.m.

Westbound lanes of Farrington Highway near Waipahu Depot Road will also be closed from Monday, July 7 to Friday, July 11 between 7 p.m. and 6 a.m.

The inside lanes of Farrington Highway between Paiwa Street and Waipahu High School will be closed from Monday, July 7 to Friday, July 11 between 7 p.m. and 6 a.m.

### PEARL CITY

Two westbound lanes and two eastbound lanes along Kamehameha Highway between Waiawa Road (near Leeward Community College) and Kuleana Road will be closed from Monday, July 7 to Friday, July 11 between 8 p.m. and 7 a.m. Left turns at the Puu Momi Street and Waimano Home Road intersections will be restricted after 8 p.m.

Two westbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway between Puu Poni Street and Kuleana Road will be closed from Monday, July 7 to Friday, July 11 between 6:30 a.m. and 3 p.m. The inner eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway in the same area will also be closed 24/7 for several weeks.

The outside eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway between Acacia Road and Waimano Home Road will be closed Monday, July 7 to Friday, July 11 between 7 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. for utility relocation work.

### AIEA

The inside eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway between Hekaha Street and Kanuku Street near Best Buy is closed 24/7, as is the left eastbound lane between Lipoa Place and

Pali Momi Street. The inside eastbound and westbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway between Hekaha Street and Kanuku Street will be closed from Monday, July 7 to Friday, July 11 between 8 p.m. and 7 a.m.

The right eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway between the Moanalua Freeway on-ramp and Salt Lake Boulevard will be closed 24/7 until further notice. One westbound lane of Kamehameha Highway in the area will be closed from Monday, July 7 to Friday, July 11 between 8:30 a.m. and 3 p.m. and between 7:30 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.

Aiea Access Road between the Moanalua Freeway on-ramp and Kamehameha Highway near Aloha Stadium will be closed from Monday, July 7 to Friday, July 11 between 10 p.m. and 4 a.m. Southbound traffic will be detoured onto Moanalua Freeway.

### AIRPORT

The left eastbound lane of Aolele Street between the U.S. Post Office and Aopoko Place will be closed from Sunday, July 6 to Thursday July 10 between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.

### KALIHI

One eastbound lane of Dillingham Boulevard between McNeill and Alakawa streets will be closed from Sunday, July 6 to Friday, July 11 between 8 a.m. and 5 a.m.

Kohou Street along the Dillingham Boulevard end of the street will be closed on Tuesday, July 8 and Wednesday, July 9 between 8 p.m. and 4 a.m.

### DOWNTOWN/KAKAAKO

Multiple eastbound lanes of Nimitz Highway between Alakawa Street and Kekaulike Street will be closed on Tuesday, July 8 between 9:30 p.m. and 3:30 a.m. the following morning.

The right lane of Halekauwila Street in both eastbound and westbound directions between Mililani Street and South Street will be closed Monday, July 7 to Friday, July 11 between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.
