## *LOOK AHEAD, NOT OVERHEAD*



Beginning next week, HART and its contractor Kiewit will begin building the rail guideway over the H-1 Freeway from Waipahu to Pearl City near the H-1/H-2 merge.

Construction crews will work at night to minimize the impact on freeway traffic.

The work will require some partial lane closures between the hours of 8 p.m. and 4 a.m. on Sunday nights through Friday mornings in order to complete the work as quickly and safely as possible.

HART encourages motorists in the area to drive with caution, and to look ahead, not overhead for the safety of drivers and workers alike.

The work is expected to be completed by mid-2016.

### *WEEKLY TRAFFIC ALERT* *Monday, December 1 to Friday, December 5*



#### **EWA**

**Farrington Highway between Kualakai Parkway (North-South Road) and Old Fort Weaver Road will remain closed in both directions until the end of January 2015.**

One westbound lane of Keahumoa Street off Kualakai Parkway also remains closed 24/7.

#### **H-1 FREEWAY WAIAWA INTERCHANGE**

Two southbound lanes of the H-2 Freeway near the H-1/H-2 merge will be closed Monday through Thursday between 8 p.m. and 4 a.m.

#### **H-1 FREEWAY WAIPAHU OFF RAMP**

The Waipahu off ramp from the H-1 Freeway westbound (Exit 8B) will be closed Monday through Thursday from 9 p.m. to 4 a.m.

#### **WAIPAHU**

**One eastbound left-turn lane from Farrington Highway onto Leoku Street and the eastbound left turn onto Leokane Street will be closed 24/7 until the end of the year.** The outside lanes of Farrington Highway near the Kunia Road overpass will be closed weeknights between 7 p.m. and 6 a.m., as will the eastbound lanes between Leoku Street and Leokane Street. The outside lanes of Farrington Highway and the northbound lane of Pupukahi Street will also be closed weeknights between 7 p.m. and 6 a.m.

Traffic will be contraflowed Monday through Friday along Farrington Highway from

Mokuola Street to Kahualii Street. Two eastbound lanes of Farrington Highway will be open between 5 a.m. and 8:30 a.m. and two westbound lanes between 3:30 p.m. and 7 p.m.

Eastbound left turns from Farrington Highway onto Moloalo Street will be restricted, as will left turns at the Paiwa Street intersection.

### **PEARL CITY**

Various sections of Kamehameha Highway along the outside lanes in both directions in Pearl City and Aiea will be closed weekdays between 7 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.

Two westbound lanes along Kamehameha Highway from Waiawa Road to Waimano Home Road will be closed weeknights between 8 p.m. and 7 a.m. and two eastbound lanes between 8 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. The Waimano Home Road intersection will be closed weeknights after 9 p.m. The eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway from Waihona Street to the merge at Farrington Highway and the westbound lanes at Waiawa Road will be closed weeknights between 7 p.m. and 6 a.m.

Two westbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway from Puu Poni Street to Kaonohi Street will be closed weeknights between 8 p.m. and 7 a.m. and two eastbound lanes will be closed between 8 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. One westbound lane will be closed Monday through Wednesday between 7 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. One eastbound lane near the HECO-Waiiau power plant and fronting Neal Blaisdell Park will be closed 24/7. Two eastbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway will be closed weekdays between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. Left turns at Kuleana Street will also be restricted. The intersection at Kaonohi Street will be closed weeknights after 9 p.m.

### **AIEA**

Two lanes of Kamehameha Highway eastbound and westbound from Pali Momi Street to Honomanu Street will be closed weeknights between 8 p.m. and 7 a.m. Eastbound drivers will be contraflowed to the westbound side of the highway during those hours.

One eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway from Lipoa Place to Pali Momi Street near the Pearl Kai Shopping Center and one near McGrew Point will be closed 24/7.

The eastbound Moanalua Freeway on-ramp near McGrew Point will be closed weeknights between 8 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Westbound drivers along Kamehameha Highway near Honomanu Street will be contraflowed to the eastbound side weeknights between 8 p.m. and 7 a.m.

The right eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway from the Moanalua Freeway on-ramp to Salt Lake Boulevard will be closed 24/7. Eastbound drivers along Kamehameha Highway near Aloha Stadium will be contraflowed to the westbound side of the highway weeknights between 8 p.m. and 7 a.m.
