Farrington Highway between Kualakai Parkway and Old Fort Weaver Road Loop weeknights 7:30 p.m. to 5 a.m. Westbound lanes closed 24/7 through April.

### H-1 FREEWAY WAIAWA INTERCHANGE

Up to three eastbound and two westbound lanes of the H-1 Freeway near the H-1/H-2 merge Sunday night through Friday morning 8 p.m. to 4 a.m.

Farrington Highway eastbound loop on-ramp onto the H-2 Freeway between 9 p.m. and 4 a.m. Sunday night through Friday morning.

### FARRINGTON HIGHWAY IN WAIPAHU

Outside lanes at various sections in both directions weekdays 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Leoku Street to Leokane Street

Inside lanes from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. weekdays. One of the two left-turn lanes onto Leoku Street closed 24/7. Left turns restricted onto Leole Street.

Leokane Street to Pupukahi Street

Westbound lanes weeknights 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Waipahu Depot Street to Mokuola Street

Outside lanes weeknights 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. Inside lanes 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Pupupuhi Street to Aniani Place

Outside lanes weeknights 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.

### KAMEHAMEHA HIGHWAY IN PEARL CITY

Waiawa Road to Acacia Road

One eastbound lane and one of the two eastbound left-turn lanes onto Acacia Road fronting

**Pearl Highlands Center 24/7.**

U-turns permitted at the intersection. One westbound left-turn lane and inside westbound lane 24/7.

Acacia Road to Waimano Home Road

One eastbound left-turn lane onto Waimano Home Road and inside eastbound lane 24/7. One westbound left-turn lane onto Lehua Avenue and inside westbound lane 24/7. U-turns at Waimano Home Road intersection permitted.

Waiawa Road to Waimano Home Road

One westbound lane near Acacia Road weeknights between 8 p.m. and 7 a.m. One eastbound lane between 7 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Intersection at Acacia Road after 9 p.m.

**KAMEHAMEHA HIGHWAY IN AIEA AND NEAR ALOHA STADIUM**

Inside westbound lane at Kaahumanu Street 24/7 Monday through Friday.

One of two eastbound left-turn lanes onto Kaahumanu closed. One of two eastbound left-turn lanes from Kaahumanu onto Kamehameha may also be closed. Kaahumanu intersection closed after 9 p.m.

Kuleana Road to Kaonohi Street

A section of Kanuku Street weeknights 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. Traffic detoured to Hekaha and Lokowai Streets. Business access to Waimalu Shopping Center and resident access maintained by special duty police officer.

Two westbound lanes weeknights 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. Two eastbound lanes 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.

Alternate lanes along Kaluamoi Place weekdays 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. One lane open at all times.

Lipoa Place to Pali Momi Street

Right eastbound lane near the Pearl Kai Shopping Center closed 24/7.

Two westbound lanes weeknights 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. Two eastbound lanes 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.

Pali Momi Street to Honomanu Street

Two westbound lanes weeknights 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. Two eastbound lanes 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. Intersection at Honomanu Street closed after 9 p.m. One eastbound lane near McGrew Point weekdays 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Near Aloha Stadium

Two westbound lanes weeknights 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. Two eastbound lanes 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.

**KAMEHAMEHA HIGHWAY IN PEARL HARBOR/AIRPORT AREAS**

Makalapa Road to Arizona Street

Two eastbound lanes weekdays 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Radford Drive Intersection

Right-turn lane weekdays 8:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Right turns permitted.

Makalapa Road to Center Drive

Two westbound lanes and one eastbound weekdays 8:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Left-turn lane into Makalapa Gate contraflowed.

Center Drive Intersection

Right-turn lane from Center Drive weekdays 8:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Bus stop westbound weekdays 8:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

Outside westbound lane of Mauka Frontage Road/Kamehameha Highway weekdays 8:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

Right lane of H-1 Freeway westbound Exit 15A weekdays 8:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

One eastbound lane of Nimitz Highway near Lagoon Drive intersection weekdays 8:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.
