



## PROGRESS AT THE RAIL OPERATIONS CENTER



Work on the construction of the Rail Operations Center in Waipahu is nearly 70 percent finished and on target to be substantially completed by about this time next year.

Crews at the 43-acre site between Waipahu High School and Leeward Community College are busy constructing the four main buildings where the fleet of 80 rail cars will be maintained and from which the rail system will be operated and monitored.

The Operations and Servicing Building will house the Operations and Control Center as well as the primary rail vehicle maintenance and repair facilities.

The Maintenance of Way Building will contain specialized equipment used to inspect and repair the guideway and tracks.

The automated Train Wash Facility is where the vehicles will be washed and cleaned regularly.

And the Wheel Truing Building will include the specialized equipment to maintain the wheels of the rail cars.

The Rail Operations Center will be environmentally-friendly and will meet Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) Silver Certification.

Pupukahi Street to Aniani Place

Outside lanes weeknights 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.

### KAMEHAMEHA HIGHWAY IN PEARL CITY

Waiawa Road to Acacia Road

One eastbound lane and one eastbound left-turn lanes onto Acacia Road fronting Pearl Highlands  
Center 24/7.

U-turns permitted at the intersection. One westbound left-turn lane and inside westbound lane 24/7.

Acacia Road to Waimano Home Road

One eastbound left-turn lane onto Waimano Home Road and inside eastbound lane 24/7. One westbound  
left-turn lane onto Lehua Avenue and inside westbound lane 24/7. U-turns at Waimano Home Road  
intersection permitted.

Kamehameha Highway to Waiawa Road

Eastbound lanes of Farrington Highway weeknights 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Waiawa Road to Waimano Home Road

One westbound lane near Acacia Road weeknights between 8 p.m. and 7 a.m. One eastbound  
lane between 7 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Intersection at Acacia Road after 9 p.m.

### KAMEHAMEHA HIGHWAY IN AIEA AND NEAR ALOHA STADIUM

Kuleana Road to Kaonohi Street

A section of Kanuku Street weeknights 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. Traffic detoured to Hekaha and Lokowai  
Streets. Business access to Waimalu Shopping Center and resident access maintained by special  
duty police officer.

Two westbound lanes weeknights 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. Two eastbound lanes 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.

Eastbound lane near Blaisdell Park closed 24/7.

Lipoa Place to Pali Momi Street

Right eastbound lane near the Pearl Kai Shopping Center closed 24/7.

Two westbound lanes weeknights 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. Two eastbound lanes 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.

### Pali Momi Street to Honomanu Street

Two westbound lanes weeknights 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. Two eastbound lanes 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. Intersection at Honomanu Street closed after 9 p.m. One eastbound lane near McGrew Point weekdays 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Inside westbound lane near Honomanu Street closed 24/7 from Friday evening, May 1 through Wednesday morning, May 6. One eastbound lane closed through this weekend.
