LEOKANE STREET INTERSECTION TO CLOSE



Construction crews will begin building the elevated rail guideway over the intersection of Farrington Highway and Leokane Street in Waipahu next week.

Beginning Monday morning, September 28 at 6 a.m. and running continuously 24/7 through the afternoon of Thursday, October 1, the intersection will be closed to cross-traffic. Drivers won't be able to drive across Farrington Highway onto Leokane Street.

All left turns at the intersection will be closed. Right turns from Farrington Highway onto Leokane Street will be permitted, as will right turns from Leokane Street onto Farrington Highway.

One lane eastbound and one lane westbound on Farrington Highway will remain open to

traffic, and flaggers will maintain pedestrian access at the intersection.

After October 1, the intersection will be closed and westbound crossovers will be in place from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. weeknights.

There will be a temporary left-turn open from Farrington Highway westbound to Leoku Street during the Leokane Street intersection work.

HART encourages motorists to drive safely through the rail construction zones.



Center Drive to Radford Drive

Two westbound lanes 8 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

Left turn only lane into Makalapa Gate routed into the contraflow lane along the median 8:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

Radford Drive to Halawa Drive

Left and right westbound lanes just beyond the Radford intersection 8:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

Westbound traffic contraflowed

Closer to the Halawa Drive intersection, the far right lane and far left lane may be intermittently closed between 8:00 am and 2:30 p.m.

Arizona Street to Makalapa Road/Gate

Up to two eastbound lanes intermittently 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Makalapa Road to Center Drive

Two eastbound lanes 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Eastbound bus stop at Makalapa Rd. temporarily relocated to mid-block 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Makai Frontage Road (off ramp) from Kamehameha Highway/Plantation Drive to Valkenburgh Street

Eastbound lane of Nimitz Highway off ramp 8:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

Aolele Street from Aolewa Place to Lagoon Drive

Single lane 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Partial lane closure westbound H-1 onramp 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Keehi Lagoon Park

A section of the road and /or within the park 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Traffic detoured to parking lot(s)
