FINAL ASSEMBLY BEGINS




HART's first two rail cars are now in final assembly at the Ansaldo Breda plant in Pittsburg, California.

Rail cars 3 and 4 have been shipped from the manufacturing plant in Reggio Calabria, Italy and are currently on their way to join the other two at final assembly in California.

HART's vehicle fleet will eventually number 80 and will move thousands of passengers congestion-free on the first fully-automated driverless metro rail system in the United States.

The first vehicle is scheduled to arrive in Honolulu in the first half of next year.

One inside lane eastbound and one westbound between Kuleana Road and Kaahumanu Street 24/7 with various left turn pocket restrictions
Westbound left turn at Kaluamoi Place. Motorsits will be detoured to Kuleana Road. Eastbound U-turns permitted at Kaahumanu Street.

Center Drive to Radford Drive

The right turn lane only lane may be closed 8 a.m. to 2:30p.m.; right turn allowed at the intersection.

The left turn only lane into Makalapa Gate contraflowed in the eastbound direction 8 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

Radford Drive to Halawa Drive
