FOUR MILES...AND COUNTING



The Honolulu Authority for Rapid Transportation (HART) has achieved another milestone with the completion of four miles of the system's elevated guideway.

Crews have now constructed more than 170 spans. A span is the portion of the guideway between two support columns. The four-mile mark is along Farrington Highway in Waipahu. To date, 290 foundations have been completed and 204 columns have been built, as the guideway makes its way through Waipahu.

The guideway segments are cast at the project's casting yard in Kapolei, and a single span requires about 12 segments. Each segment weighs about 50 tons. About 3,290 segments have been cast, in preparation for guideway construction.

"We continue to make progress on the construction of our rail project," said HART

Executive Director and CEO Dan Grabauskas. "Safety is our top priority, and we want to thank the public for their patience, and for driving safely through our construction zones."

Single lane of Exit 15A weekdays 8:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

Kamehameha Highway from Center Drive to Radford Drive

Two westbound lanes 8 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

Left turn only lane into Makalapa Gate routed into the contraflow lane along the median 8:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

Westbound Bus Stop relocated to the island at the Radford intersection.

Kamehameha Highway from Radford Drive to Halawa Drive

Right turn only lane from Radford Drive 8:00 am to 2:30 p.m.

All westbound lanes just beyond the Radford intersection 8:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Westbound traffic contraflowed

Westbound bus stop at Radford Drive temporarily relocated to the island at the intersection 8:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

Closer to the Halawa Drive intersection, the far right lane and far left lane may be intermittently closed between 8:00 am and 2:30 p.m.

Kamehameha Highway from Arizona Memorial Place to Arizona Street

Up to two eastbound lanes intermittently 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

A small section of the left lane utilized as contraflow lane 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Kamehameha Highway from Makalapa Road to Center Drive

One eastbound lane 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Eastbound bus stop at Makalapa Rd. temporarily relocated to mid-block 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Makai Frontage Road (off ramp) from Kamehameha Highway/Plantation Drive to Valkenburgh Street

Eastbound lane of Nimitz Highway off ramp 8:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

Aolele Street from Aolewa Place to Lagoon Drive

Single lane 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Partial lane closure westbound H-1 onramp 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.
