TREE RELOCATIONS



Have you ever wondered what happens to the trees that are removed to make way for the elevated rail guideway and rail stations?

The trees are transplanted, and this month, HART and the state of Hawaii Department of Transportation have been busy planting relocated trees along the Moanalua Freeway near Red Hill.

HART has been working closely with other agencies, including the Department of Parks and Recreation, the Division of Urban Forestry, Department of Enterprise Services, the Navy, and other community groups to identify suitable locations for transplanting

The Patsy T. Mink Central Oahu Regional Park, Neal S. Blaisdell Park, Ala Wai Golf

Course and Waiiau District Park are some of the other recipients of transplanted trees.

Work will occur periodically over the next several months as trees are removed and transplanted from construction areas for the rail project to other locations around town.

FARRINGTON HIGHWAY IN KAPOLEI/EWA

Kualakai Parkway to Old Fort Weaver Road Loop

7:30 p.m. to 5 a.m. weeknights

H-1 FREEWAY WAIAWA INTERCHANGE

H-1 westbound Waipahu off-ramp 9 p.m. to 4 a.m. Sunday night through Friday morning.
Farrington Highway eastbound on-ramp to H-1 eastbound 9 p.m. to 4 a.m.
Up to three inside lanes or two outside lanes in both directions of the H-1 Freeway will be closed from 8 p.m. (9 p.m. westbound) to 4 a.m. Sunday through Thursday.

FARRINGTON HIGHWAY NEAR LEEWARD COMMUNITY COLLEGE

Closed westbound lanes of Farrington Highway near Waiawa Road will be crossed over to the eastbound side from 8 p.m. to 4 a.m. Sunday through Friday.

FARRINGTON HIGHWAY IN WAIPAHU

Outside lanes at various sections in both directions weekdays 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Old Fort Weaver Road to Leoku Street

Inside lanes and eastbound left turns onto Fort Weaver Road 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. weekdays.

Leoku Street to Leokane Street

Inside lanes 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. including Saturday as needed and weeknights 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Closed eastbound lanes at Leoku Street will be crossed over 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Leokane to Pupukahi Street

On Sunday, October 25, left turns at Leokane Street will be closed. Farrington Highway crossing through Leokane Street intersection will be closed. Inside lanes of Farrington Highway closed.

Inside lanes closed from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. weekdays and Saturday

Pupukahi to Pupupuhi Street

INTERSECTION CLOSURE AT PUPUPUHI STREET

From 6 a.m. Thursday, October 29 continuously through 3:30 p.m. on Sunday November 1

left turns from Farrington Highway to Pupupuhi Street will be closed. Inside lanes of Farrington Highway will be closed.

Inside lanes 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Pupupuhi Street to Aniani Place

Left turns at Pupupuhi closed 24/7

Inside lanes 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. weekdays

Inside lanes 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Northbound/Southbound traffic crossing Farrington Highway at Pupupuhi Street will be closed.

Aniani Place to Waipahu Depot Street

Inside lanes 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Waipahu Depot Street to Mokuola Street

Inside lanes 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Left turn eastbound at Mokuola Street 24/7

Left turn westbound at Waipahu Depot Street 8 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Paiwa Street to Kahualii Street

Traffic will be contraflowed at the Kahualii Street intersection. One lane will remain open in each direction during non-peak travel times.

Temporary eastbound lane will provide 2 lanes of travel Monday through Friday from 6 a.m. to 9 a.m.

Closed eastbound lanes at Kahualii Street will be crossed over 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Left turn eastbound at Kahualii Street 24/7

Inside lanes weekdays 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Outside lane from Kahualii Street to the H-1 eastbound on-ramp 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

KAMEHAMEHA HIGHWAY IN PEARL CITY

Waiawa Road to Acacia Road

Two westbound left-turn lanes and inside westbound lane 24/7.

One eastbound lane 24/7.

One westbound lane 8 p.m. to 7 a.m.

Acacia Road to Waimano Home Road

One eastbound left-turn lane onto Waimano Home Road and inside eastbound lane 24/7.

One westbound left-turn lane onto Lehua Avenue and inside westbound lane 24/7.

Waimano Home Road to Puu Momi Street

Inside eastbound lane 24/7 Two eastbound lanes will remain open during peak travel times.

One eastbound lane weeknights 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.

Two westbound lanes weeknights 8 p.m. to 7 a.m.

Puu Momi Street to Puu Poni Street

Inside eastbound lane 24/7 with various left turn restrictions

Two westbound and two eastbound lanes to remain open during peak travel

times

Puu Poni Street intersection closed after 8:30 p.m. Eastbound motorists detoured to Puu Momi Street and Kaahumanu Street

KAMEHAMEHA HIGHWAY IN AIEA AND NEAR ALOHA STADIUM

Puu Poni Street to Kuleana Road

Inside eastbound lane 24/7

Two westbound lanes 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. with various left turn restrictions.

One eastbound lane 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. and 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

One westbound lane weekdays 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Left turn at Kuleana Road is closed. Motorists detoured to Kaahumanu Street

Kuleana Road to Kaonohi Street

One inside lane eastbound and one inside lane westbound 24/7 between Kanuku Street and Kaonohi Street with left turn restrictions

One inside lane eastbound and one westbound between Kuleana Road and Kaahumanu Street 24/7 with various left turn pocket restrictions

Westbound left turn at Kaluamoi Place 24/7. Motorsits will be detoured to Kuleana Road and Kaahumanu Street.

One eastbound lane 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. and 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

One westbound lane 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. with various left turn restrictions.

One westbound lane and one eastbound lane 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Lipoa Place to Pali Momi Stree

Two westbound lanes weeknights 8 p.m. to 7 a.m.

Two eastbound lanes 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.

One westbound lane 8 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Pali Momi Street to Honomanu Street

One westbound lane and one eastbound lane 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Two westbound lanes weeknights 8 p.m. to 7 a.m.

Two eastbound lanes 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.

Near Aloha Stadium-Honomanu Street to Salt Lake Boulevard

On-ramp to Moanalua Freeway 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. Sunday through Thursday

Up to three westbound lanes weeknights 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. with various left turn restrictions

Two eastbound lanes 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.

One westbound lane weekdays 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Up to three westbound lanes of Salt Lake Boulevard weeknights 8 p.m. to 7 a.m.

Eastbound lanes crossed over to the westbound lanes 8 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.

KAMEHAMEHA HIGHWAY IN PEARL HARBOR/AIRPORT AREAS

Center Drive to Radford Drive

Two westbound lanes 8 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

The right turn lane only lane may be closed 8 a.m. to 2:30p.m.; right turn allowed at the intersection.

The left turn only lane into Makalapa Gate contraflowed in the eastbound direction 8 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

Radford Drive to Halawa Drive

One lane intermittently 8:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

The westbound bus stop may be temporarily relocated 8 am to 2:30 p.m.

Arizona Memorial Place to Arizona Street

One eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway closed between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.

Arizona Street to Makalapa Road/Gate

Two eastbound lanes 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Makalapa Road to Center Drive

Up to two eastbound lanes 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Eastbound bus stop at Kamehameha Highway and Makalapa Rd. may be temporarily relocated to mid-block 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Makai Frontage Road/Nimitz Hwy Eastbound from Kamehameha Highway/Plantation Drive to Valkenburgh Street and from Hickam AFB to H-1 On-ramp

One eastbound lane of Nimitz Highway in two locations 8:30 a.m. and 2:30 p.m.

Aolele Street from Aolewa Place to Lagoon Drive

Single westbound lane 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.
