THE RAIL OPERATIONS CENTER IS NEARLY COMPLETE



The Honolulu Rail Transit Project's Rail Operations Center in Waipahu

The Rail Operations Center (ROC) in Waipahu is nearing completion of the 43-acre site. It is located off of Farrington Highway between Leeward Community College (LCC) and Waipahu High School. The site includes four major structures:

- Operations & Servicing Building
 - Operations and Control Center and primary vehicle maintenance, inspection and repair facilities.
- Maintenance of Way Building

- Facility to house the specialized equipment used to inspect and repair the guideway, stations and track.
- Train Wash Facility
 - Automated train wash facility to clean the exterior of the rail vehicles using recycled water.
- Wheel Truing Building
 - Facility with specialized equipment to maintain rail vehicle wheels.

The ROC will provide maintenance, inspections and repairs of the rail vehicles. Additionally, it will be a storage for the trains when they are not in operation, and a testing ground prior to operation.
