Aloha Mr. Grabauskas,

Thank you for the opportunity to review the National Register of Historic Places nomination forms for Waimalu Stream Bridge, Kalauao Springs Bridge, and Kalauao Stream Bridge (nominations), received by the Hawaii State Historic Preservation Division (SHPD) on April 16, 2014. Per the *Programmatic Agreement among the US Department of Transportation Federal Transit Administration the Hawaii State Historic Preservation Officer the United States Navy and the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation Regarding the Honolulu High-Capacity Transit Corridor Project in the City and County of Honolulu, Hawaii (PA) Stipulation VI.C National Register Nominations* SHPD has reviewed the nominations and determined they are consistent with the requirements of the PA and previous consultation. SHPD requires no further work or corrections and accepts the above cited documents as the final drafts. Kalauao Springs Bridge, Kalauao Stream Bridge, and Waimalu Stream Bridge do not appear to be eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places due to previous alterations made by road improvement projects in the recent past. They lack integrity of design, setting, materials, workmanship, feeling, and association.
