
TRAFFIC PLANS

- For the safety of work crews and the public, all westbound lanes and the sidewalk on Farrington Highway between Leokane Street and Leoku Street will be closed. Westbound traffic will be contraflowed with one lane open in each direction.
- **No crossing over Farrington Highway** mauka-makai at Leoku Street and Leokane Street intersections.
- **No left turns** from any direction at both the Leoku Street and Leokane Street intersections. Motorists needing to make eastbound left turns may be detoured to the Makai side of Farrington Highway. Motorists needing to make westbound left turns may detour through Pupukahi Street.
- Traffic measures, aided by special duty police officers, will be in place.
- Mauka businesses may be accessed from Leoku Street or Leokane Street.




