FARRINGTON HIGHWAY REOPENED NEAR KAHI MOHALA



Farrington Highway near Kahi Mohala has been reopened. Crews have restored the roads and installed a new guardrail.

The Honolulu Rail Transit Project has reopened Farrington Highway near Kahi Mohala, this week. This area of the highway has been closed off and on over the past few years for the safety of motorists and workers as Kiewit crews worked to construct the elevated rail guideway.

"We want to thank the public for its patience and understanding during our construction," said HART Executive Director and CEO Dan Grabauskas. "We are happy to provide a newer and smoother roadway in return."

Kiewit has restored parts of Farrington Highway and continues to repave and restripe the

roadway through Waipahu.

In observance of the Fourth of July weekend, Kiewit crews will not be conducting night work on the Honolulu Rail Transit Project on Sunday, July 3. In addition, all contractors associated with the project will not perform any work on Monday, July 4.


