RAIL CONSTRUCTION UPDATE FOR KAMEHAMEHA HIGHWAY

Kiewit made the final concrete pour, this week for the balanced cantilever work over the H-1 Freeway in Pearl City near the Sears Distribution Center. Over the next several weeks, the yellow travelers will be removed. The final minimum clearance over the townbound lanes is 18 ft. 3 in. and gradually increases across all freeway lanes.

Kiewit crews also made the final pour for the drilled shaft operations near Aloha Stadium. This is the 186th shaft for the Kamehameha Highway section of the project. In total, there are 495 shafts in the first 10 miles from East Kapolei to Aloha Stadium. Drilled shafts are foundations for the columns.
