Kamehameha Highway – Pearl Harbor Area

Monday, May 1, 2017 to Friday, May 5, 2017

LOCATION: Kohomua Street to Kalaloa Street/Arizona Memorial Place Intersection

Daytime: 6:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., Monday through Friday

Outside or inside westbound lane of Kamehameha Highway will be closed.

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday

Up to two inside eastbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway will be closed.

LOCATION: Arizona Memorial Place to Arizona Street

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday

Up to two outside or inside eastbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway will be closed.

LOCATION: Halawa Drive/Arizona Street Intersection to Radford Drive/Makalapa Road Intersection

Daytime: 6:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., Monday through Friday

One outside or inside westbound lane of Kamehameha Highway will be closed. The left-turn from eastbound Kamehameha Highway onto Radford Drive will be intermittently closed.

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday

Up to two outside or inside eastbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway will be closed.

LOCATION: Radford Drive/Makalapa Road Intersection to Plantation Drive/Center Drive Intersection

Daytime: 6:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., Monday through Friday

Up to two outside or two inside westbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway will be closed.

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday

Up to two outside or two inside eastbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway will be closed.

LOCATION: H-1 Off Ramp to Main Street

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday

One eastbound lane will be closed.

Airport Area

LOCATION: Ualena Street between Ohohia Street and Lagoon Drive

Nighttime: 8 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday through Friday

LOCATION: Waiwai Loop

Nighttime: 8 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday through Friday
