Week of May 7, 2017

Kamehameha Highway – Pearl Harbor Area

Monday, May 8, 2017 to Friday, May 12, 2017

LOCATION: Kohomua Street to Kalaloa Street/Arizona Memorial Place Intersection

Daytime: 6:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., Monday through Friday

Outside or inside westbound lane of Kamehameha Highway will be closed.

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday

Up to two inside eastbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway will be closed.

LOCATION: Arizona Memorial Place to Arizona Street

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday

Up to two outside or inside eastbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway will be closed.

LOCATION: Halawa Drive/Arizona Street Intersection to Radford Drive/Makalapa Road Intersection

Daytime: 6:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., Monday through Friday

One outside or inside westbound lane of Kamehameha Highway will be closed. The left-turn from eastbound Kamehameha Highway onto Radford Drive will be intermittently closed.

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday

Up to two outside or inside eastbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway will be closed.

LOCATION: Radford Drive/Makalapa Road Intersection to Plantation Drive/Center Drive Intersection

Daytime: 6:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., Monday through Friday

Up to two outside or two inside westbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway will be closed.

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday

Up to two outside or two inside eastbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway will be closed.

LOCATION: H-1 Off Ramp to Main Street

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday

One eastbound lane will be closed.

Various left-turn and right-turn pockets along Kamehameha Highway may also be closed intermittently for potholing operations. Bike lanes and pedestrian sidewalks may also be closed to accommodate work. Special Duty Officers will be on site to assist with turning movements, and pedestrian detours at affected intersections.

Airport Area

LOCATION: Ualena Street between Ohohia Street and Lagoon Drive

Nighttime: 8 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday through Friday

Either the mauka or makai side of the street and sidewalk will be closed. Traffic movements, driveways access, and pedestrian assistance will be provided by Flaggers and/or Special Duty Officers. Street parking will be restricted during hours of operation.

LOCATION: Waiwai Loop

Nighttime: 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday through Friday

Either the mauka or makai side of the street and sidewalk will be closed. Traffic movements, driveways access, and pedestrian assistance will be provided by Flaggers and/or Special Duty Officers. Street parking will be restricted during hours of operation.
