

## TRAFFIC UPDATE – Pearl Harbor / Airport

Week of July 23, 2017

### Kamehameha Highway – Pearl Harbor Area

Monday, July 24, 2017 to Saturday, July 29, 2017

#### LOCATION: Kohomua Street to Kalaloa Street/Arizona Memorial Place Intersection

**Daytime: 6:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., Monday through Saturday**

Outside or inside westbound lane of Kamehameha Highway will be closed.

**Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Saturday**

Up to two outside or inside eastbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway will be closed.

**Nighttime: 8 pm to 5 am, Monday through Saturday**

The eastbound right-turn lane from Kamehameha Highway onto Arizona Memorial Place will be closed. Right turns permitted from center-through lane.

#### LOCATION: Arizona Memorial Place to Arizona Street

**Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Saturday**

Up to two outside or inside eastbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway will be closed.

**Daytime: 8 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., Monday through Saturday**

Up to two inside eastbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway will be closed.

**Nighttime: 8 pm to 5 am, Monday through Saturday**

A portion of the right eastbound lane of Kamehameha will be closed.

#### LOCATION: Halawa Drive/Arizona Street Intersection to Radford Drive/Makalapa Road Intersection

**Daytime: 6:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., Monday through Saturday**

One outside or inside westbound lane of Kamehameha Highway will be closed.

**Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Saturday**

Up to two outside or inside eastbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway will be closed. Left-turn from Kamehameha Highway to Radford Drive interminably closed. Eastbound drivers will be detoured to Valkenburgh Street.

#### LOCATION: Radford Drive/Makalapa Road Intersection to Plantation Drive/Center Drive Intersection

**Daytime: 6:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., Monday through Saturday**

Up to two outside or two inside westbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway will be closed.

**Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Saturday**

Up to two outside or two inside eastbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway will be closed.

#### Plantation Drive/Center Drive Intersection to H1-Ramp

**Daytime: 6:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., Monday through Saturday**

Up to two inside or center westbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway will be closed. No left turn onto Center Drive or for North Nimitz motorists from westbound Kamehameha. Motorists will be detoured to a u-turn at Radford Drive.

**Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday through Saturday**

Outside westbound lane of Kamehameha Highway will be closed. The right-turn lane from Kamehameha Highway to Radford Drive will be closed. Right turns will be permitted from the right-through westbound lane. The right-turn lane from Plantation Drive onto Kamehameha Highway will be closed. All traffic will be permitted the left traffic lane.

**Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Saturday**

One inside eastbound lane of Kamehameha Highway will be closed.

*Various left-turn and right-turn pockets along Kamehameha Highway may also be closed intermittently for potholing operations. Bike lanes and pedestrian sidewalks may also be closed to accommodate work. Special Duty Officers will be on site to assist with turning movements, and pedestrian detours at affected intersection*

## Airport Area

Monday, July 24, 2017 to Saturday, July 29, 2017

**LOCATION: Ala Onaona Street between Aolele Street to Lei Stands Entrance**

**Nighttime: 10 p.m. to 4 a.m., Monday through Saturday**

Roadway may be closed for work. Flagger will allow access as needed.

**LOCATION: Ala Auana Street between Ala Onaona Street to Rodgers Boulevard**

**Nighttime: 10 p.m. to 4 a.m., Monday through Saturday**

Roadway may be closed for work.

**LOCATION: Airport Parking Garages at Toll Plaza Road**

**Nighttime: 10 p.m. to 4 a.m., Monday through Saturday**

One or two lanes may be closed at a time.

**LOCATION: Ala Onaona Street/Aolele Street between Airport Parking Garage Exit to H-1 On-Ramp**

**Nighttime: 10 p.m. to 4 a.m., Monday through Saturday**

Aolele Street Eastbound access from Ala Onaona Street may be closed. Detour to Aolele Street westbound and Nimitz Highway. Access to H-1 will remain.

**Nighttime: 10 p.m. to 4 a.m., Monday through Saturday**

H-1 on-ramp from Ala Onaona Street may be closed. Detour to Aolele Street Eastbound and Nimitz Highway.

**LOCATION: Aolele Street at Paiea Street Intersection**

**Nighttime: 10 p.m. to 4 a.m., Monday through Saturday**

Left turn lanes eastbound will be closed. Special Duty Officer will assist with turns as needed.

**LOCATION: Aolele Street between Paiea Street and Lagoon Drive**

**Nighttime: 10 p.m. to 4 a.m., Monday through Saturday**

One lane may be closed; flagger will operate bi-directional traffic. No street parking allowed during work hours.
