

TRAFFIC UPDATE – Airport

Week of August 27, 2017

KAMEHAMEHA HIGHWAY – PEARL HARBOR AREA

Monday, August 28, 2017 to Friday, September 1, 2017

LOCATION: Halawa Drive/Arizona Street Intersection to Radford Drive/Makalapa Road Intersection

Daytime: 6:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., Monday through Friday

One outside or inside westbound lane of Kamehameha Highway will be closed.

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday

Up to two outside or inside eastbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway will be closed. Left-turn from Kamehameha Highway to Radford Drive interminably closed. Eastbound drivers will be detoured to Valkenburgh Street.

Nighttime: 8 p.m. to 4 a.m., Monday through Friday

Westbound direction of Kamehameha Highway will be closed. Westbound traffic will be contra-flowed in the eastbound lanes of Kamehameha Highway around the construction area. Speed limit will be reduced to 25 mph in both the eastbound and westbound lanes.

AIRPORT

Monday, August 28, 2017 to Friday, September 1, 2017

LOCATION: Ala Onaona Street between Aolele Street to Lei Stands Entrance

Nighttime: 10 p.m. to 4 a.m., Monday through Friday

Roadway may be closed for work. Flagger will allow access as needed.

LOCATION: Aolele Street at Paiea Street Intersection

Nighttime: 10:00 p.m. to 4:00 a.m., Monday through Friday

Intermittent closures near the Middle Street intersection. Various left-turn and right-turn pockets may be closed. Special Duty Officers will be on-site to assist with traffic movements.

LOCATION: Aolele Street between Paiea Street and Lagoon Drive

Nighttime: 10:00 p.m. to 4:00 a.m., Monday through Friday

One lane may be closed. Flagger will operate bi-directional traffic in remaining lane. No street parking allowed during work hours.

KALIHI

Monday, August 28, 2017 to Friday September 1, 2017

LOCATION: Kamehameha Highway between Middle Street and Puuhale Road

Nighttime: 8:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m., Monday - Friday

Up to two lanes will be closed on eastbound and westbound Kamehameha Highway. Work will include intermittent closures near the Middle Street intersection. Various left-turn and right-turn pockets may be closed. Highway ramps may also be affected. Special Duty Officers will be on-site to assist with traffic movements. Bike lanes, bus stops and sidewalks may be impacted by the work.
