

TRAFFIC UPDATE – City Center

KALIHI

Sunday, September 24, 2017 to Saturday September 30, 2017

LOCATION: Nimitz Highway between Puuloa Road/Lagoon Drive and Nimitz Highway Off-Ramp

Nighttime: 9:00 p.m. to 4:30 a.m., Sunday - Tuesday

Eastbound lanes of Nimitz Highway will be closed at the Nimitz Highway Off-Ramp. Motorists will be detoured at Dillingham Boulevard.

LOCATION: Dillingham Boulevard Intersection at Mokauea Street

Nighttime: 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m., Sunday – Thursday

Two eastbound lanes of Dillingham Boulevard will be closed. Eastbound traffic will be contra-flowed in the westbound lanes of Dillingham Boulevard around the construction area. Westbound traffic will be reduced to one lane. The left-turn from eastbound Dillingham Boulevard onto Mokauea Street will be closed. Special Duty Officers will be on-site to assist with traffic movements. Bike lanes, bus stops and sidewalks may be impacted by the work.

LOCATION: Mokauea Street between Elewene Street and Kaumualii Street Intersection

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday - Friday

Both lanes of Mokauea Street will be closed. The closure will remain open for local traffic and TheBus. Motorists will be detoured to Kalihi Street.

LOCATION: Dillingham Boulevard between Colburn Street and Kohou Street
