KAMEHAMEHA HIGHWAY – PEARL HARBOR AREA

LOCATION: Halawa Drive Intersection (Borchers Gate)

Nighttime: 8:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m., Monday to Saturday

The right-turn from westbound Kamehameha Highway to Halawa Drive will be closed. Motorists will be detoured to a u-turn at Arizona Memorial Place.

LOCATION: Halawa Drive/Arizona Street to Radford Drive/Makalapa Road

Daytime: 6:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., Monday to Thursday

One lane on westbound Kamehameha Highway will be closed.

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday to Thursday

Up to two lanes on eastbound Kamehameha Highway will be closed.

Nighttime: 8:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m., Monday to Thursday

Up to two lanes on eastbound Kamehameha Highway will be closed.

LOCATION: Plantation Drive/Center Drive to H-1 Interchange

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday through Saturday

The inside lane on eastbound Kamehameha Highway will be closed.

Daytime: 6:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., Monday through Saturday

The inside through lane on westbound Kamehameha Highway will be closed. The left-turn from westbound Kamehameha Highway onto Center Drive will be closed, although turning movements will be maintained.

Special Duty Officers will be on site to assist with turning movements, and pedestrian detours at affected intersection.

Kamehameha Highway is now reduced to two lanes in each direction for project construction. Speed limit reduced to 25 mph in both directions. Various left-turn and right-turn pockets along Kamehameha Highway may also be closed intermittently for work. Special Duty Officers will be on site to assist with turning movements, and pedestrian detours at affected intersection. Bus stops will be relocated when affected by construction. Pedestrian access will be maintained. Bicycle lanes have also been removed due to space constraints for construction.

WAIWAI LOOP

Daytime: 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Sunday to Thursday

Street parking fronting the business will be restricted during hours of operation.

NIMITZ HIGHWAY

LOCATION: H-1 On-Ramp from Kamehameha Highway

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday through Thursday

The travel lane on eastbound H-1 On-Ramp will be shifted to the shoulder.

LOCATION: Kamehameha Highway Off-Ramp to Nimitz Highway

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday through Thursday

One lane on eastbound Kamehameha Highway Off-Ramp will be closed.

LOCATION: H-1 Off-Ramp to Nimitz Highway Interchange

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday through Thursday

Up to two lanes on westbound Kamehameha Highway will be closed.

The travel lane on eastbound H-1 Off-Ramp will be shifted to the shoulder.

LOCATION: Nimitz Highway/Kamehameha Highway and Valkenburgh Street Intersection

Nighttime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday to Thursday

One lane will be intermittently closed in each direction leading up to and through the intersection on Nimitz Highway and Valkenburgh Street. Bike lanes, bus stops and sidewalks may be impacted and closed. Special Duty Officers and on-site flaggers and personnel will assist with traffic as needed.
