

TRAFFIC UPDATE - Farrington Highway

Week of November 12, 2017

KAPOLEI

Monday, November 13, 2017 to Saturday, November 18, 2017

LOCATION: Kualaka'i Parkway at Keahumoa Parkway

24 Hours a Day, Seven Days a Week

The outside lanes of eastbound and westbound Keahumoa Parkway will be closed. The westbound sidewalk will also be closed. Pedestrians will be detoured to the eastbound sidewalk. A minimum of one lane in each direction will be open.

Note: Due to overhead crane work, traffic may be stopped intermittently for no more than 5 minutes due to safety for commuters and pedestrians.

LOCATION: Kualaka'i Parkway between Keahumoa Parkway and Farrington Highway

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday to Friday

A single outside lane of mauka Kualakai'i Parkway or a single outside lane makai lane of Kualaka'i Parkway will be closed near the UH West O'ahu rail station site.

LOCATION: Leoku Street to Leokane Street

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday to Saturday

Alternating lanes of westbound Farrington Highway will be closed.

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday to Saturday

Alternating lanes of eastbound Farrington Highway will be closed.

LOCATION: Waipahu Depot Street to Mokuola Street

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday to Saturday

Alternating lanes of westbound Farrington Highway will be closed.

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday to Saturday

Alternating lanes of eastbound Farrington Highway will be closed.

Nighttime: 9:00 p.m. to 6:30 a.m., Friday to Saturday

All eastbound lanes of Farrington Highway and sidewalk will be closed. Eastbound traffic will be detoured north on Waipahu Depot Street, east on Hikimoe Street, south on Mokuola Street, then back onto Farrington Highway. Flaggers and special duty officers will be onsite to assist pedestrians and commuters as needed.

LOCATION: Moloalo Street between Mokuola Street and Sherwin Williams

24 Hours a Day, Seven Days a Week

The area fronting the station site along Moloalo Street will be closed.

Shoulder and median work signage/cones along the side of the road will mark the work area. Motorists are advised to drive with caution and provide a safe distance between themselves, the construction workers and vehicles. *Lane closures are subject to change.
