LOCATION: Mokauea Street between Colburn Street and Hau Street

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday to Tuesday

The makai-bound lane of Mokauea Street will be closed. The closure will remain open for local traffic and TheBus. The Hau and Colburn intersections will remain open. Motorists will be detoured to Kalihi Street.

LOCATION: Mokauea Street between Dillingham Boulevard and Eluwene Street Intersection

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday to Tuesday

Mokauea Street will be closed. Access will be maintained for TheBus and local traffic via flaggers and onsite personnel. Motorists will be detoured to Kalihi Street.

LOCATION: Eluwene Street between Mokauea Street and Puuhale Road

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday to Tuesday

No parking makai side of Eluwene Street fronting St. Germaine's Bakery.

LOCATION: Mokauea Street between Eluwene Street and Kaumualii Street Intersection

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday to Tuesday

Mokauea Street will be closed. Access will be maintained for TheBus and local traffic via flaggers and onsite personnel. Motorists will be detoured to Kalihi Street.

LOCATION: Dillingham Boulevard between Colburn Street and Kohou Street

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday to Tuesday

The eastbound sidewalk of Dillingham Boulevard will be closed. The bus stop will remain open.

Special Duty Officers or flaggers will be on-site to assist with traffic movements and pedestrians as needed.
