Nighttime: 8:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m., overnights Sunday to Wednesday

The inside through lane on westbound Kamehameha Highway will be closed. The left-turn from westbound Kamehameha Highway onto Center Drive will be closed. Motorists will be detoured to a u-turn at Radford Drive. Special Duty Officers will be on site to assist with traffic and pedestrians.

For the safety of crews and the traveling public, the speed limit has been reduced to 25 mph on Kamehameha Highway between Salt Lake Boulevard/ Ford Island Bridge and Center Drive. The highway has been reduced to two lanes in each direction during construction. Bike lanes have been removed due to space constraints. Please drive safely; observe the posted speed limit, follow construction and directional signs, and share the road with bicyclists.

Daytime: 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday to Tuesday

Street parking fronting the business will be restricted during hours of operation.

NIMITZ HIGHWAY

Monday, November 20, 2017 to Tuesday, November 21, 2017

LOCATION: H-1 Eastbound On-Ramp from Kamehameha Highway

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday and Tuesday

Eastbound travel lane will be narrowed.

LOCATION: Kamehameha Highway Off-Ramp to Nimitz Highway

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday and Tuesday

Alternating lanes of eastbound off-ramp will be closed.

LOCATION: H-1 Off-Ramp to Nimitz Highway

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday and Tuesday

Eastbound travel lane may be shifted to the shoulder.

LOCATION: Nimitz Highway/Kamehameha Highway and Valkenburgh Street Intersection

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., overnights Sunday to Friday

Alternating eastbound and westbound lanes will be intermittently closed leading up to and through the intersection. Turning movements may be restricted. Bike lanes, bus stops and sidewalks may be closed. Special Duty Officers and on-site flaggers and personnel will assist with traffic as needed. Access will be maintained to Joint-Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam. Bus stops will be relocated when affected by construction. Pedestrian access will be maintained.

Nighttime: 8:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m., overnights Sunday to Wednesday

Alternating eastbound and westbound lanes will be intermittently closed leading up to and through the intersection. Turning movements may be restricted. Bike lanes, bus stops and sidewalks may be closed. Special Duty Officers and on-site flaggers and personnel will assist with traffic as needed. Access will be maintained to Joint-Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam. Bus stops will be relocated when affected by construction. Pedestrian access will be maintained.

AIRPORT

Monday, November 20, 2017 to Wednesday, November 22, 2017

LOCATION: Aolele Street at Paiea Street Intersection

Nighttime: 10:00 p.m. to 4:00 a.m., overnights Sunday to Wednesday

Alternating eastbound and westbound lanes leading up to and through the intersection will be closed. Alternating turn lanes will be intermittently closed. Special Duty Officers will assist with traffic as needed.

LOCATION: Paiea Street to Aolewa Place

Nighttime: 10:00 p.m. to 4:00 a.m. overnights Monday to Wednesday

One lane will be intermittently closed. On-site flaggers and personnel will control traffic movements via open lane.
