

## TRAFFIC UPDATE - Farrington Highway

### Week of December 3, 2017

#### KAPOLEI

Monday, December 4, 2017 to Saturday, December 9, 2017

**LOCATION: Kualaka'i Parkway at Keahumoa Parkway**

**24 Hours a Day, Seven Days a Week**

The outside lanes of eastbound and westbound Keahumoa Parkway will be closed. The westbound sidewalk will also be closed. Pedestrians will be detoured to the eastbound sidewalk. A minimum of one lane in each direction will be open.

***Note: Due to overhead crane work, traffic may be stopped intermittently for no more than 5 minutes due to safety for commuters and pedestrians.***

**LOCATION: Kualaka'i Parkway between Keahumoa Parkway and Farrington Highway**

**Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday to Saturday**

Alternating outside lane of mauka Kualakai'i Parkway or a single outside makai lane of Kualaka'i Parkway will be closed near the UH West O'ahu rail station site.

***\*Please note all left-turn and intersection closures mentioned below will not conflict with closures at adjacent intersections.***

**LOCATION: H-1 Freeway at Manager's Drive**

**Nighttime: 12:00 a.m. to 4:00 a.m., Friday**

Three left lanes of westbound H-1 Freeway will be closed between the Waikele exit and Manager's Drive.

**LOCATION: Leoku Street to Leokane Street**

**Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday to Saturday**

Alternating lanes of westbound Farrington Highway will be closed.

**Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday to Saturday**

Alternating lanes of eastbound Farrington Highway will be closed.

**LOCATION: Waipahu Depot Street to Mokuola Street**

**Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday to Saturday**

Alternating lanes of westbound Farrington Highway will be closed.

**Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday to Saturday**

Alternating lanes of eastbound Farrington Highway will be closed.

**LOCATION: Moloalo Street between Mokuola Street and Sherwin Williams**

**24 Hours a Day, Seven Days a Week**

The area fronting the station site along Moloalo Street will be closed.

***Shoulder and median work signage/cones along the side of the road will mark the work area. Motorists are advised to drive with caution and provide a safe distance between themselves, the construction workers and vehicles. \*Lane closures are subject to change.***
