

TRAFFIC UPDATE - Farrington Highway

Week of December 31, 2017

There will be no travel lane closures for the HART Holiday Moratorium from Friday, December 22, 2017 to Monday, January 1, 2018. HART may permit work within this time where noted.

LOCATION: Kualaka'i Parkway at Keahumoa Parkway

24 Hours a Day, Seven Days a Week

The outside lanes of eastbound and westbound Keahumoa Parkway will be closed. The westbound sidewalk will also be closed. Pedestrians will be detoured to the eastbound sidewalk. A minimum of one lane in each direction will be open.

Note: Due to overhead crane work, traffic may be stopped intermittently for no more than 5 minutes due to safety for commuters and pedestrians.

Alternating lanes of eastbound Farrington Highway will be closed.

LOCATION: Aniani Place to Waipahu Depot Street

Daytime: 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Tuesday to Saturday

One alternating lane of westbound Farrington Highway will be closed.

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Tuesday to Saturday

One alternating lane of eastbound Farrington Highway will be closed.

LOCATION: Waipahu Depot Street to Mokuola Street

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Tuesday to Friday

Alternating lanes of westbound Farrington Highway will be closed.

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Tuesday to Friday

Alternating lanes of eastbound Farrington Highway will be closed.

LOCATION: Moloalo Street between Mokuola Street and Sherwin Williams

24 Hours a Day, Seven Days a Week
