

TRAFFIC UPDATE - Farrington Highway

Week of February 11, 2018

KAPOLEI

Sunday, February 11, 2018 to Saturday, February 17, 2018

LOCATION: Kualaka'i Parkway at Keahumoa Parkway

24 Hours a Day, Seven Days a Week

The outside lanes of eastbound and westbound Keahumoa Parkway will be closed. The westbound sidewalk will also be closed. Pedestrians will be detoured to the eastbound sidewalk. A minimum of one lane in each direction will be open.

Note: Due to overhead crane work, traffic may be stopped intermittently for no more than 5 minutes due to safety for commuters and pedestrians.

WAIPAHU

Sunday, February 11, 2018 to Saturday, February 17, 2018

LOCATION: Leoku Street to Leokane Street

Daytime: 6:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday to Friday

Alternating lanes of westbound Farrington Highway will be closed.

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday to Friday

Alternating lanes of eastbound Farrington Highway will be closed.

Nighttime: 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m., Monday to Tuesday

All westbound lanes of Farrington Highway and sidewalk will be closed. Westbound traffic will be detoured at Leokane Street to southbound to Leonui Street, or northbound to Waipahu Street. Flaggers and special duty officers will be onsite to assist pedestrians and commuters as needed.

LOCATION: Aniani Place to Waipahu Depot Street

Daytime: 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday to Saturday

Alternating lanes of westbound Farrington Highway will be closed.

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday to Saturday

The inside lane of eastbound Farrington Highway will be closed.

LOCATION: Waipahu Depot Street to Mokuola Street

Daytime: 6:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday to Saturday

Alternating lanes of westbound Farrington Highway will be closed.

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday to Friday

Alternating lanes of eastbound Farrington Highway will be closed.

Nighttime: 8:30 p.m. to 5:00 a.m., Wednesday to Saturday

The inside lane of eastbound Farrington Highway will be closed.

LOCATION: Moloalo Street between Mokuola Street and Sherwin Williams

24 Hours a Day, Seven Days a Week

The area fronting the station site along Moloalo Street will be closed.

Shoulder and median work signage/cones along the side of the road will mark the work area. Motorists are advised to drive with caution and provide a safe distance between themselves, the construction workers and vehicles. *Lane closures are subject to change.
