

TRAFFIC UPDATE - Farrington Highway

Week of April 1, 2018

KAPOLEI

Sunday, April 1, 2018 to Saturday, April 7, 2018

LOCATION: Kualaka'i Parkway at Farrington Highway

24 Hours a Day, Seven Days a Week

The inside left lane of southbound Kualaka'i Parkway will be closed between Farrington Highway and Keahumoa Parkway. Two southbound travel lanes will remain open through the work zone.

LOCATION: Kualaka'i Parkway at Keahumoa Parkway

24 Hours a Day, Seven Days a Week

The outside lanes of eastbound and westbound Keahumoa Parkway will be closed. The westbound sidewalk will also be closed. Pedestrians will be detoured to the eastbound sidewalk. A minimum of one lane in each direction will be open.

Note: Due to overhead crane work, traffic may be stopped intermittently for no more than 5 minutes due to safety for commuters and pedestrians.

WAIPAHU

Sunday, April 1, 2018 to Saturday, April 7, 2018

LOCATION: Leoku Street to Leokane Street

Daytime: 6:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday to Friday

Alternating lanes of westbound Farrington Highway will be closed.

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday to Friday

Alternating lanes of eastbound Farrington Highway will be closed.

LOCATION: Leonui Street between Leole Street and Leoleo Street

Daytime: 6:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday to Friday

The westbound lane of Leonui Street will be closed between Leole Street and Leoleo Street. The adjacent pedestrian sidewalk will also be closed to accommodate work.

LOCATION: Waipahu Depot Street to Mokuola Street

Daytime: 6:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday to Friday

Alternating lanes of westbound Farrington Highway will be closed.

Daytime: 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday to Friday

Alternating lanes of eastbound Farrington Highway will be closed.

Nighttime: 8:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m., overnights Monday to Friday

All westbound lanes of Farrington Highway and sidewalk will be closed. Westbound traffic will be detoured north on Mokuola Street, west on Hikimoe Street, south on Waipahu Depot Street, then back onto Farrington Highway. Flaggers and special duty officers will be onsite to assist pedestrians and commuters as needed.

LOCATION: Moloalo Street between Mokuola Street and Sherwin Williams

24 Hours a Day, Seven Days a Week

The area fronting the station site along Moloalo Street will be closed.

Shoulder and median work signage/cones along the side of the road will mark the work area. Motorists are advised to drive with caution and provide a safe distance between themselves, the construction workers and vehicles. *Lane closures are subject to change.
